

Description of HBAG Committees & Committee Appointment Process

Associates Council: The Associates Council promotes membership and oversees all matters relating to Associate members of HBAG. The Council meets generally three times a year at HBAG meetings.
Appointment Process: Appointed by the local association in September of every year.

B-PAC Trustees: The B-PAC Trustees aid through campaign contributions those candidates for state and local office who support the goals of the Home Builders Association.
Appointment Process: Nominated by the local association on odd/even years and elected at the Fall Board Meeting by the trustees.

Budget & Finance Committee: The Budget and Finance Committee studies the finances of the association, makes recommendations on financial policies to the Executive Committee and the Board of Directors and assists in preparation of the Annual budget.
Appointment Process: Appointed by the President in July/August of every year.

Builder Action Fund:
The Builder Action Fund Committee is charged with the responsibility of administering the Builder Action Fund. Subject to approval by the committee, funds from the Builder Action Fund may be used to support legal and regulatory issues that impact the housing industry in Georgia.
Appointment Process: Six builders appointed by the President.

Bylaws Committee: The Bylaws Committee is responsible for reviewing the association's bylaws and recommending needed amendments to the Executive Committee.
Appointment Process: HBAG President appoints up to ten members per year in July/August.

Executive Committee: The Executive Committee is responsible for receiving requests for action, expenditures, or policy from any committee or member and recommending action regarding these requests to the Board of Directors. The committee may also act for the board between board meetings subject to ratification by the board.
Appointment Process: is mostly done by the President July/August

Government Affairs Committee: The Government Affairs Committee reviews all state and national legislation affecting the housing industry.
Appointment process: Is appointed by the President in July/August of every year.

Meetings Committee: The Meetings Committee has jurisdiction over all matters relating to meetings with recommendation to the executive committee and the board.

Appointment Process: President appoints nine members in July/August of every year.

Nominating Committee: The Nominating Committee certifies and qualifies all candidates for office.

Appointment Process: six members appointed by the president in July/August of every year.

Regulatory Affairs Committee: The Regulatory Affairs Committee is responsible for monitoring codes and regulations and serves as liaison to state regulatory agencies.

Appointment Process: appointed 19 members by the president in July/August of every year.

Note: All new appointments to committees start on October 1st of every year.
